INTRODUCTION



NZE Maama Children's Organisation is a nonprofit organisation founded in 2019 in Uganda. It is dedicated to supporting vulnerable children through education, nutrition, medical, and foster care programs. To further our mission of providing motherly love and care, we are launching a Skilling Project aimed at equipping children with vocational training. This initiative

will help prepare them for self-sufficiency and meaningful employment while contributing to the financial sustainability of our organisation.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- 1. Equip children with practical vocational skills to enable self-reliance and career readiness.
- 2. Produce African-inspired and personalized items such as sandals, bangles, earrings, necklaces, belts, wallets, and more.
- 3. Generate revenue to support the activities and programs of NZE Maama Children's Organisation.
- 4. Foster creativity and entrepreneurship among the children and youth we serve.

PRODUCTS AND PRICING

Our Skilling Project will produce handcrafted African-inspired products that include (Photos of product samples attached on the last page):

• Sandals , Bangles , Earrings , Necklaces , Belts , Wallets , Shoes , Hats and Art pieces

Price Range: \$5 to \$300 per item, with personalized items priced at a premium.

SALES CHANNELS:

- 1. Online shop on the NZE Maama website.
- 2. Physical shop located at our centre or any designated location and we shall also supply to other interested buyers in Uganda.

EMPOWERING CHILDREN THROUGH SALES

A significant aspect of this project is empowering children to directly contribute to their education. For example, if a child sells 10 crafts at \$10 each, generating \$100, these funds can be used to pay for his or her school fees. This approach helps reduce reliance on donations, which may not always be available, and instills a sense of ownership and achievement in the children.

FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

To launch the Skilling Project, we require funds of \$13,000, divided into two phases:

- 1. **Phase 1:** \$5,400 Focused on acquiring essential materials and basic equipment to begin operations.
- 2. **Phase 2:** \$7,600 Expansion of materials, advanced equipment, and additional training resources.

BUDGET BREAKDOWN (PHASE 1: \$5,400)

- 1. Materials: Leather, beads, threads, tools, dyes, etc. \$1,800
- 2. Equipment: Sewing machines, cutting tools, workbenches, etc. \$3,200
- 3. Training: Trainer fees, manuals, and initial workshops \$1,000
- 4. First Aid: Basic supplies and kits \$200
- 5. Marketing & Launch: Online and local promotion materials \$200
